**NOTIFICATION OF SVUSD PROMOTION REQUIREMENTS**

To be promoted from the 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grades, a student must:

- a. Earn a cumulative grade point average of 1.50 in all classes and earn at least a 1.0 GPA in English and mathematics each year;
- b. Earn "no more than a total of three (3) F's in English, Math, History and/or Science courses during each school year. Students who fail more than three English, Math, History, and/or Science courses at either the 7<sup>th</sup> grade level or 8<sup>th</sup> grade level must repeat all the course requirements at that grade level.

A student not meeting the above requirements may be promoted to the next grade level if all of the above requirements are successfully completed during summer school. In the case of a fiscal crisis where state and local funding does not allow for summer school, the superintendent or designee may allow students, who need summer school to meet promotion requirements, to be socially promoted to the next grade level subject to the existing conditions for social promotion. Socially promoted students will NOT be permitted to participate in the promotion ceremony or related activities. To participate in the intermediate school 8<sup>th</sup> grade promotion ceremony, a student must have earned academic promotion from the 8<sup>th</sup> grade prior to the ceremony.

**REQUIRED COURSES FOR PROMOTION**

**To be promoted to the next grade, a student must complete the following required subjects:**

All four Saddleback Valley Unified School District Intermediate schools operate on the trimester system, which divides the academic year into three twelve-week sessions.

Summer school provides an option both for making up a maximum of three (3) failed classes, and raising the student's grade point average.
